Dr. John Nash was awarded a Pulitzer Prize in Economics in 1994 for his theory of equilibrium (Governing Dynamics). He was featured in the movie *A Beautiful Mind*. In that movie Russell Crowe, playing Nash explained his theory by saying, "Adam Smith (the father of modern economics) wrote, in competition, individual ambitions serve the common good".
